



CATEGORY Award for Sharing and Learning

- This award is for the individual(s) or team who can demonstrate a practical example of how they actively collaborated, influenced or enhanced a learning and sharing culture within the area of Safety at their employing company, place of work or within OEUK and or Step Change in Safety.
- The contribution to Safety could be through their participation in a workgroup over a sustained period of time, their involvement in developing and introducing guidance or compilation of a high value learning opportunity.

Entry Criteria

- Candidates must be either a company, team or individual working in the energy industry.
- Entry must describe an activity pertinent to the energy industry.
- Clear demonstrable positive effects must be shown.

Judging Criteria

- Summarise the issue that was identified.
- Describe how the issue was addressed.
- Very clear evidence of tangible learning and sharing benefits.
- Clearly illustrate the roles of the individual, team or company in developing and implementing the shared idea.
