



CATEGORY Award for Wellbeing

This award is for an individual(s) or team who have actively engaged in improving their working Environment and or company approach to employee wellbeing. Areas to consider in this category could be wellbeing linked to mental and or physical health.

Entry Criteria

- Candidates should be employed at the worksite or be directly involved in supporting the worksite.
- They should have made a demonstrable and positive impact in the area of wellbeing at their worksite or employing company.
- Candidates should be nominated by their worksite supervisor, or work colleague.
- Please ensure all nominees are aware of the nomination submission.

Judging Criteria

- Examples of how the individual(s) team has improved wellbeing at the worksite or within the employing company must be provided.
- Specific examples of how this has positively influenced the wellbeing of those at the worksite should also be provided.
